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As per the student's feedback for 2023-2024, The overall atmosphere of the college campus is rated positively, with 37.7% of students describing it as excellent and 55.8% as good. A strong majority (89.6%) feel safe and secure on campus. Satisfaction with the availability and accessibility of computer labs, libraries, and study spaces is generally high, with 29.9% very satisfied and 46.8% satisfied. An overwhelming majority (93.5%) are satisfied with the quality of teaching provided by faculty members, while 6.5% are not. Most students (87.0%) believe that course material and curriculum are relevant and up-to-date, with 9.1% feeling somewhat and 3.9% not feeling so. A majority (79.2%) are satisfied with the responsiveness of faculty and staff to academic needs. Most students (76.6%) feel adequately informed about campus events, deadlines, and academic policies
